

- Never let the power cord come into contact with other cables! Handle the power cord and all connections with the mains with particular caution! Never remove warning or informative labels from the unit.
- Never use anything to cover the ground contact.

- Do not insert objects into air vents.

- Do not switch the device on and off in short intervals, as this will reduce the device's life.
- Do not touch the device's housing bare-handed during its operation (housing becomes very hot).
- Do not shake the device. Avoid brute force when Installing or operating the device.
- Only use the device indoors, avoid contact with water or other liquids.
- Only operate the fixture after having checked if the housing is firmly closed and all screws are tightly
- Only operate the device after having familiarized with its functions.
- Avoid flames and do not put close to flammable liquids or gases.
- Always keep the case closed while operating.
- Always replace the lamp, when it is damaged or deformed due to the heat.
- Always allow a free air space of at least 50 cm around the unit for ventilation.
- Always disconnect power from the mains, when device is not used or before cleaning or when replacing lamp! Only handle the power cord holding it by the plug. Never pull out the plug by tugging the power cord.
- Make sure that the device is not exposed to extreme heat, moisture or dust.
- Make sure that the available voltage is not higher than stated on the rear panel.
- Make sure that the power cord is never crimped or damaged. Check the device and the power cord from time to time.
- If the lens is obviously damaged, it has to be replaced, so that its functions are not impaired due to cracks or deep scratches.
- If device was dropped or struck, disconnect mains power supply immediately. Have a qualified engineer Inspect for safety before operating.
- If the device has been exposed to drastic temperature fluctuation (e.g. after transportation), do not switch it on immediately. The arising condensation water might damage your device. Leave the device switched off until it has reached room temperature:
- If your Showtec device fails to work properly, discontinue the use Immediately. Pack the unit securely (preferably in the original packing material), and return it to your Showtec dealer for service.
- For adult use only. The fixture must be installed beyond the reach of children. Never leave the unit running unattended.
- Never attempt to bypass the thermostatic switch or fuses.
- For replacement use lamps and fuses of same type and rating only.
- The user is responsible for correct positioning and operating of the Blacklight. The manufacturer will not accept liability for damages caused by the misuse or incorrect installation of this device.
- Allow time to cool down, before replacing lamp.
- This device falls under protection class I. Therefore it is essential to connect the yellow/green
- Repairs, servicing and electric connection must be carried out by a qualified technician. WARRANTY: Till one year after date of purchase.

# **Operating Determinations**

- This device is not designed for permanent operation. Consistent operation breaks will ensure that the device will serve you for a long time without defects.
- The minimum distance between light output and the illuminated surface must be bigger than 1
- The maximum ambient temperature ta = 25°C must never be exceeded.
- The relative humidity must not exceed 50 % with an ambient temperature of 25° C.
- If this device is operated in any other way than the one described in this manual, the product may suffer damages and the warranty becomes void.
- Any other operation may lead to dangers like short-circuit, burns, electric shock, crash, etc.


Please follow the European and national guidelines concerning rigging, trussing and all other safety issues.


Do not attempt the installation yourself! Always let the installation be carried out by an authorized dealer!

#### Procedure:

- If the projector is lowered from the ceiling or high joists, professional trussing systems have to be used.
- Use a clamp to mount the projector, with the mounting bracket, to the trussing system.
- The projector must never be fixed swinging freely in the room.
- The installation must always be secured with a safety attachment, e.g. an appropriate safety net or safety cable
- When rigging, derigging or servicing the projector, always make sure, that the area below the installation site is secured and that there are not any unauthorized people around.







The Blacklight can be mounted to any kind of truss with a clamp.

Improper installation can cause serious injuries and/or damage of property!

Connect the device to the mains with the power-plug. Always check if the right color cable is connected to the right place.

A Return Procedure

Returned merchandise must be sent prepaid and in the original packing, call tags will not be issued. Package must be clearly labeled with a Return Authorization Number (RMA number). Products returned without an RMA number will be refused. Highlite will not accept the returned goods or any responsibility Call Highlite 0031-455667723 or mail aftersales@highlite.nl and request an RMA prior to shipping the fixture. Be prepared to provide the model number, serial number and a brief description of the cause for the return. Be sure to properly pack fixture, any shipping damage resulting from Inadequate packaging is the customer's responsibility. Highlite reserves the right to use its own discretion to repair or replace product(s). As a suggestion, proper UPS packing or double-boxing is always a safe method to use.

#### Claims

The client has the obligation to check the delivered goods immediately upon delivery for any shortcomings and/or visible defects, or perform this check after our announcement that the goods are at their disposal. Damage incurred in shipping is the responsibility of the shipper; therefore the damage must be reported to the carrier upon receipt of merchandise.

It is the customer's responsibility to report and submit claims with the shipper in the event that a fixture is damaged due to shipping. Transportation damage has to be reported to us within one day after receipt of the delivery.

Any return shipment has to be made post-paid at all times. Return shipments must be accompanied with a letter defining the reason for return shipment. Non-prepaid return shipments will be refused, unless agreed otherwise in writing.

Complaints against us must be prepared in writing or sent by fax within 10 working days after receipt of the invoice. After this period complaints will not be handled anymore.

Complaints will only then be considered if the client has so far complied with all parts of the agreement, regardless of the agreement from which the obligation is resulting.





#### Installation

Remove all packing materials from the Blacklight Spot 400W. Check if all foam and plastic padding is removed. Connect all cables.

Do not supply power before the whole system is set up and connected properly. Always disconnect from electric mains power supply before cleaning or servicing. Damages caused by non-observance are not subject to warranty.

## Set Up and Operation

Follow the directions below, as they pertain to your preferred operation mode. Before plugging the unit in, always make sure that the power supply matches the product specification voltage. Do not attempt to operate a 120V specification product on 230V power, or vice versa. Connect the device to the main power supply.





# Maintenance

The operator has to make sure that safety-related and machine-technical installations are to be inspected by an expert after every year in the course of an acceptance test. The operator has to make sure that safety-related and machine-technical installations are to be inspected by a skilled person once a year.

The following points have to be considered during the inspection:

- 01) All screws used for installing the device or parts of the device have to be tightly connected and must not be corroded
- 02) There may not be any deformations on housings, fixations and installation spots.
- 03) Mechanically moving parts like axles, eyes and others may not show any traces of wearing.
- 04) The electric power supply cables must not show any damages or material fatigue.

The Blacklight Spot 400W requires almost no maintenance. However, you should keep the unit clean. Otherwise, the fixture's light output will be significantly reduced. Disconnect the mains power supply, and then wipe the cover with a damp cloth. Do not immerse in liquid.

Please clean internal components once a year with a light brush and vacuum cleaner. Make sure connections are thoroughly dry before supplying electric power.

Changing the lamp

- 01) Disconnect mains power supply. Allow 15 minutes for the lamp to cool down.
- 02) Follow directions for Installing the lamp, page 9.

Replacing the Fuse

Power surges, short-circuit or inappropriate electrical power supply may cause a fuse to burn out. If the fuse burns out, the product will not function whatsoever. If this happens, follow the directions below to do

01) Unplug the unit from electric power source.

02) Insert a screwdriver into the slot in the fuse cover. Turn the fuse holder counterclockwise. The fuse will come out.

03) Remove the used fuse. If brown or unclear, it is burned out.

04) Insert the replacement fuse into the holder where the old fuse was. Reinsert the fuse holder. Be sure to use a fuse of the same type and specification. See the product specification label for details.

If the light effect does not operate properly, refer servicing to a technician.

Suspect three potential problem areas as: the power supply, the lamp, the fuse.

O1) Power supply Check if the unit is plugged into an appropriate power supply.

O2) The lamp. Return the Blacklight to your Showted dealer.

O3) The fuse. Replace the fuse. See page 10 for replacing the fuse.

O4) If all of the above appears to be O.K., plug the unit in again.


